We have one entry point for visitors into the school located at the front entrance.

All visitors are required to sign in electronically, and visitors' badges should be worn.

All visitors are reminded of Health and Safety procedures and are escorted throughout the building.

If at any time a visitor behaves in an unacceptable manner, then they will be asked to leave the premises immediately. The UL Staff Protection Policy and its guidelines would be followed.
